





CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

HUNTER DIVISIONS

All hunter fences will consist of natural rails, coops, gates, in & outs, walls. All hunters judged on performance, manners and soundness. Jumping classes will be shown over approximately eight fences. Hunter under saddle classes will be shown at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horses mouth is required. Suitability will be emphasized in all pony classes.

HUNT TEAMS - FOX HUNTERS

Shown over a course simulating obstacles in hunting country. Judged on performance, soundness, manner and suitability as field hunters.

HUNTER DERBY

To be judged on an even hunting pace, manners and way of going and style of jumping. To be eligible, a horse or pony must have been entered, shown and completed the course in at least two over fences classes at this show. Entries will jump one round of approximately ten fences. The top 12 entries will return to jump a second round of approximately eight fences. The entry with the lowest score will return first. Scoring of the two rounds will be cumulative.

JUMPER DIVISION

A category of classes in which the horse's (or pony's) score is based on a designated number of fault points for each jumping and/or time error. The overall object of the jumper class is to test the horse's ability to jump difficult obstacles without errors within a specified time.

HIGH JUMP CONTEST

Conducted over a single obstacle, starting at approximately 3'9". Each competitor is allowed three attempts to clear a particular height and receives three points for clearing it at the first attempt, two for the second and one for the third. Points are cumulative from start to finish of class. Failure on the third attempt eliminates.

EQUITATION DIVISION

The rider's ability alone is judged. Hunter seat equitation riders compete either over fences or on the flat, and are judged on position and their ability to produce an accurate performance.

LEADLINE, MINI STIRRUP & SHORTEST STIRRUP

For young children in which the rider's ability, dress and suitability of mount is judged.

THE FAMILY CLASS

Two or more riders from the same family are judged on performance and unity as a group. Shown at the walk and trot both directions.

T.I.P.

Open to thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club, competing as hunters or jumpers.

MODEL & HANDLER CLASSES

Horse or pony to be shown in hand and moved on the line. To be judged on the presentation of the animal, neatness and appearance of the handler, and overall condition of the animal. Conformation will not be a determining factor.
